Dear Judge Hendrix:

The State of Texas and the Texas Racing Commission (collectively "Texas") understand the Court's conditions for granting permissive intervention to be as follows: Texas

- 1. may join the Plaintiffs' existing partial motion for summary judgment as requested;
- 2. although present at the hearings on February 16, 2022, did not participate in oral argument;
- 3. may not pursue their anti-commandeering claim until the parties outstanding motions have been resolved;
- 4. may not conduct discovery until the parties' outstanding motions have been resolved; and
- 5. may not relitigate any issues already decided.

Based on that understanding, Texas accepts the Court's conditions and wishes to proceed with their motion to intervene.
