MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

Defendant-Appellee Teamsters Local 2010("Local 2010") respectfully moves to stay the briefing schedule in this appeal pending this Court's decision in *Belgau v. Inslee*, No. 19-35137.

Defendant-Appellee Napolitano does not oppose this motion. Defendant-Appellee the Attorney General of California takes no position on this motion. Plaintiffs-Appellants ("Plaintiffs") oppose this motion.

This appeal presents the same legal issues that are presented in the appeal in *Belgau v. Inslee*, No. 19-35137, which was argued before the Ninth Circuit on December 10, 2019 and is currently under submission. The appellants in *Belgau*, like Plaintiffs in this case, are public sector employees who claim that their First Amendment rights were violated when their employers deducted union membership dues that the employees had agreed to pay by signing union membership and dues deduction authorization agreements. Like the district court here, the district court in *Belgau* rejected those claims. Other federal district courts have rejected similar claims, and plaintiffs in some of those cases have filed appeals.

This Court has stayed pending a decision in *Belgau* further appellate proceedings in at least six of those other cases that raise the same basic legal issues: *Quirarte v. United Domestic Workers of America*, No. 20-55266;

Grossman v. Hawaii Government Employees' Assoc., No. 20-15356;
Mendez v. California Teachers Association, No. 20-15394; Hernandez v.
AFSCME California, No. 20-15076; Seager v. United Teachers Los Angles,
No. 19-55977; Smith v. Teamsters Local 2010, No. 19-56503; and Smith v.
Bieker, No. 19-16381; . See Exhibit 1 (stay orders). Further proceedings in
this case should similarly be stayed until the Court issues a decision in
Belgau.

Plaintiffs filed their opening brief in this appeal on December 27, 2010. Dkt. 8. Defendants-Appellees Local 2010, the Attorney General of California, and Napolitano filed their answering briefs on March 3, 2020. Dkt. 15, Dkt. 17, Dkt. 19. Plaintiffs filed their reply brief on March 23, 2020. Dkt. 27. Plaintiffs' briefing in this appeal presents legal arguments that are largely identical to many of the arguments presented by the appellants in *Belgau*. This Court's decision in *Belgau* is thus likely to control the outcome of this appeal, and it will at least have significant implications for the resolution of this case.

To best utilize judicial and party resources and most efficiently resolve this appeal, the Court should stay further appellate proceedings until this Court issues its decision in *Belgau v. Inslee*, No. 19-35137.
