TEAMSTERS LOCAL 429'S MOTION TO DISMISS PLAINTIFFS' COMPLAINT PURSUANT TO FED. R. CIV. P. 12(b)(1) AND 12(b)(6)

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1) and 12(b)(6), Defendant Teamsters Local 429 ("Local" or "Union")¹ moves to dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint in its entirety. Specifically, the Local moves to dismiss Plaintiffs' Section 1983 claim asserted in Count II as well all forms of relief sought thereunder as it fails to state a claim as a matter of law. Additionally, the Local moves to dismiss Plaintiffs' Section 1983 claim asserted in Count I to the extent that it seeks prospective monetary, declaratory, or injunctive relief because such claims for relief are moot. Finally, the Local moves to dismiss Plaintiffs' Section

1983 claim asserted in Count I to the extent that it seeks retroactive monetary,

declaratory, or injunctive relief because Plaintiffs have failed to state a claim for

relief, the Local has valid defenses, and/or the claims for relief are moot. In support

of this Motion, the Local submits a Declaration of Kevin Bolig, which is attached

as Exhibit "1." For these reasons and as more fully explained in the memorandum

of law to be filed pursuant to Local Rule 7.5, Teamsters Local 429 respectfully

request this Court grant the Union's Motion and dismiss with prejudice Plaintiffs'

Complaint in its entirety.

DECLARATION OF KEVIN BOLIG

I, Kevin Bolig, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, based on my personal knowledge, declare the following facts to be true and correct:

- 1. I am currently the Secretary-Treasurer of Teamsters Local 429 ("Local"), and work at its main office at 1055 Spring Street, Wyomissing, PA 19610. I have served in this capacity since July 2015. Prior to that, I served as the Business Agent of the Local from January 1, 2003 until the end of June 2015. During my tenure at the Local, I have been assigned to provide representation to the bargaining unit employees at Lebanon County, including Plaintiffs in this case.
- 2. In my current position with the Local, I am familiar with the Plaintiffs' history of employment, their membership or non-membership in the Local, their correspondence to the Local seeking to resign membership, and the Local's response to those requests.

- 3. On or about April 14, 2003, Plaintiff Hollie Adams ("Ms. Adams") was hired by Lebanon County.
- 4. On or about May 6, 2003, Ms. Adams signed a union authorization card, whereby she became a union member of the Local. (A true and correct copy of her signed union authorization card is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "A.")
- 5. Prior to July 10, 2018, Ms. Adams never requested to resign her membership in the Local.
- 6. On or about July 10, 2018, Ms. Adams sent a letter to the Local requesting to resign her membership, which the Local received on July 13, 2018. (A true and correct copy of the July 10, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "B.")
- 7. On or about August 13, 2018, the Local responded to her July 10, 2018 letter, denying her request based on the terms of her dues authorization card. (A true and correct copy of the August 13, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "C.")
- 8. On or about August 30, 2018, Ms. Adams sent a second letter to the Local requesting to resign her membership, which the Local received on September 4, 2018. (A true and correct copy of the August 30, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "D.")

- 9. On or about September 7, 2018, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Adams, reiterating the terms of her dues authorization card and notifying her that dues deductions will cease March 2019. (A true and correct copy of the September 7, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "E.")
- 10. On or about March 5, 2019, the Local notified Lebanon County to cease dues deductions for Ms. Adams. The last dues deductions received by the Local from Lebanon County for Ms. Adams occurred on or about March 5, 2019.
- 11. From the time she requested to resign her membership until dues deductions ceased, the Local received \$416.00 in dues deductions from Lebanon County for Ms. Adams.
- 12. On or about May 7, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Adams confirming that the Local had accepted her resignation of her membership and that dues deductions had ceased. (A true and correct copy of the May 7, 2019 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "F")
- 13. On or about May 10, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Adams advising her that the Local was refunding all dues deductions received by the Local from the time she requested to resign her membership until dues deductions ceased. Enclosed in the letter was a check for \$440.96, representing the \$416.00 in dues deductions received by the Local, as well as six percent statutory interest. (A

true and correct copy of the May 10, 2019 letter and the enclosed check is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "G.")

- 14. On or about December 14, 2009, Plaintiff Christopher Felker ("Mr. Felker") was hired by Lebanon County.
- 15. On or about January 26, 2010, Mr. Felker signed a union authorization card, whereby he became a member of the Local. (A true and correct copy of her signed union authorization card is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "H.")
- 16. Prior to September 28, 2018, Mr. Felker never requested to resign his membership in the Local.
- 17. On or about September 28, 2018, Mr. Felker sent a letter to the Local requesting to resign his union membership, which the Local received on October 1, 2018. (A true and correct copy of the September 28, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "I.")
- 18. On or about October 5, 2018, the Local sent a letter to Mr. Felker informing him that the Local accepted his resignation of his membership and dues deductions would cease by November 2018. (A true and correct copy of the October 5, 2019 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "J.")
- 19. The last dues deductions received by the Local from Lebanon County for Mr. Felker occurred on or about October 29, 2018.

- 20. From the time he requested to resign his membership until dues deductions ceased, the Local received \$96.00 in dues deductions from Lebanon County for Mr. Felker.
- 21. On or about May 7, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Mr. Felker confirming that the Local had accepted his resignation of membership and that dues deductions had ceased. (A true and correct copy of the May 7, 2019 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "K.")
- 22. On or about May 10, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Mr. Felker advising him that the Local was refunding all dues deductions received by the Local from the time he requested to resign his membership until dues deductions ceased. Enclosed in the letter was a check for \$101.76, representing the \$96.00 in dues deductions received by the Local, as well as six percent statutory interest. (A true and correct copy of the May 10, 2019 letter and the enclosed check is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "L.")
- 23. On or around October 2015, Plaintiff Karen Unger ("Ms. Unger") was hired by Lebanon County.
- 24. Ms. Unger did not sign a union authorization card at or near the time she started employment with Lebanon County but instead paid a fair share fee as a non-member.

- 25. On or about November 7, 2017, Ms. Unger signed a union authorization card, whereby she became a member of the Local. (A true and correct copy of her signed union authorization card is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "M.")
- 26. From the time she became a member of the Local until July 10, 2018, Ms. Unger never requested to resign her membership in the Local.
- 27. On or about July 10, 2018, Ms. Unger sent a letter to the Local requesting to resign her membership, which the Local never received until Lebanon County forwarded a copy of the letter at the end of August 2018. (A true and correct copy of her July 10, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "N.")
- 28. On or about August 31, 2018, the Local requested that Lebanon County cease dues deductions for Ms. Unger. The last dues deductions received by the Local from Lebanon County for Ms. Unger occurred on or about October 1, 2018.
- 29. From the time she requested to resign her membership on July 10, 2018 until dues deductions ceased, the Local received \$88.00 in dues deductions from Lebanon County for Ms. Unger.
- 30. On or about May 7, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Unger confirming that the Local had accepted her resignation and that dues deductions

had ceased. (A true and correct copy of the May 7, 2019 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "O.")

- 31. On or about May 10, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Unger advising her that the Local was refunding all dues deductions received by the Local from the time she requested to resign union membership until dues deductions ceased. Enclosed in the letter was a check for \$93.28, representing the \$88.00 in dues deductions received by the Local, as well as six percent statutory interest. (A true and correct copy of the May 10, 2019 letter and the enclosed check is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "P.")
- 32. On or about June 18, 2007, Plaintiff Jody Weaber ("Ms. Weaber") was hired by Lebanon County.
- 33. On or about July 31, 2007, Ms. Weaber signed a union authorization card, whereby she became a union member of the Local. (A true and correct copy of her signed union authorization card is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "O.")
- 34. Prior to July 16, 2018, Ms. Weaber never requested to resign her membership in the Local.
- 35. On or about July 16, 2018, Ms. Weaber sent a letter to the Local requesting to resign her union membership, which the Local received on July 23,

- 2018. (A true and correct copy of her July 23, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "R.")
- 36. On or about August 30, 2018, Ms. Weaber sent a second letter to the Local requesting to resign her membership, which the Local received on September 4, 2018. (A true and correct copy of her August 30, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "S.")
- 37. On or about September 7, 2018, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Weaber, explaining the terms of her dues authorization card and notifying her that union dues deductions will cease June 2019. (A true and correct copy of the September 7, 2018 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "T.")
- 38. On or about March 5, 2019, the Local notified Lebanon County to cease dues deductions for Ms. Weaber. The last dues deduction received by the Local from Lebanon County for Ms. Weaber occurred on or about March 5, 2018.
- 39. From the time she requested to resign her membership until dues deductions ceased, the Local received \$392.00 in dues deductions from Lebanon County for Ms. Unger.
- 40. On or about May 7, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Weaber advising her that the Local had accepted her resignation and that dues deductions had ceased. (A true and correct copy of the May 7, 2019 letter is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "U.")

- 41. On or about May 10, 2019, the Local sent a letter to Ms. Weaber advising her that the Local was refunding all dues deductions received by the Local from the time she requested to resign her membership until dues deductions ceased. Enclosed in the letter was a check for \$415.52, representing the \$392.00 in dues deductions received by the Local, as well as six percent statutory interest. (A true and correct copy of the May 10, 2019 letter and the enclosed check is attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "V.")




