Legislative Intervenor-Defendants, Philip E. Berger, President Pro-Tem of the Senate, and Timothy K. Moore, Speaker of the House (together, the "Legislative Defendants")file this First Amended Motion to Dismiss pursuant to N.C.G.S. §1A-I, Rule 12(b)(1) for lack of subject matter

jurisdiction and Withdrawal of their Motion to Dismiss under Rule 12(b)(6). Plaintiffs' Complaint is devoid of any factual allegations showing that they suffered or are likely to suffer harm as a result of the matters alleged in their Complaint. They have failed to show the existence of a case or controversy, and as such, they lack standing to bring this action.

Legislative Defendants further request that this First Amended Motion to Dismiss be heard along with Defendants' Amended Motion to Dismiss and both groups' Motions to Transfer at the next scheduled hearing in this case, which is set for Thursday, May 6, 2021 at 2:00 p.m.

WHEREFORE, Legislative Defendants request that this Court dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint, with prejudice, in its entirety, as against all parties, and tax the costs of this litigation to the Plaintiffs.

FURTHER, Legislative Defendants hereby WITHDRAW (i) their initial Motion to Dismiss Pursuant to Rules 12(b)(1) and (6) and (ii) their Motion to Stay Discovery, filed jointly with the Nunn Intervenor-Defendants.
