STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL

This case involves a challenge to Executive Order 14042. On December 28, 2021, shortly after Plaintiffs filed suit, the Court stayed proceedings in this matter because another federal district court had already preliminarily enjoined the federal government from enforcing Executive Order 14042, thus providing Plaintiffs the relief they were seeking in this case. *See* Order Staying the Case, ECF No. 36. This case has remained stayed ever since. In May 2023, the President revoked Executive Order 14042. *See* Executive Order 14099 §§ 2–3, 88 Fed. Reg. 30,891 (May 9, 2023).

Accordingly, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), Plaintiffs, by stipulation, hereby dismiss this action without prejudice. Each side shall bear their own fees and costs.
