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TO: Defendants above-named, through counsel, via ECF

Plaintiffs move the Court pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65, D. Minn. L.R. 7.1, and the Court’s inherent authority for the following relief:

1. A preliminary injunction which prohibits the enforcement of Minn. Stat. § 211B.075 until this lawsuit is decided on its merits;
2. That no bond be required for the injunction pursuant to the Court’s inherent authority to waive any bon requirement.
