PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION**

This matter came before the Court pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65 and Plaintiff Allison Roberts's motion for a preliminary injunction.

Based upon all the files, records, and proceedings herein, pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and for good cause shown, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Allison Roberts's motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Court finds that Allison Roberts is likely to succeed on the merits of her claims that the District's Harassment Policy and Nondisclosure Policy are unconstitutional, both on their face and as applied to Allison Roberts.
3. The Court finds that Allison Roberts and other affected parents within the District will suffer irreparable harm absent a preliminary injunction.
4. The Court finds that the balance of equities and public interest favor granting Allison Roberts's Motion.
5. Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c), no bond is required in connection with this Order.
6. During the pendency of this action, Defendants Portland Public Schools, Chandra Wilson-Cooper, and Deanne Froehlich, in

their official capacities, together with District officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all persons acting for, with, by, through, under, or in active concert with Defendants, are barred from enforcing the Harassment Policy and Nondisclosure Policy.

7. Defendants are further ordered to cease or comply with all other requests for relief presented in Allison Roberts's motion.
